## **DESCRIPTION**:

Operational Context Zhytomyr's MSF vision is to innovate in the Drug Resistant – Tuberculosis (DR-TB) care in the Ukrainian context, adapting the model to the needs and constraints of the region. This project will focus on always keeping the patient-centered approach as key, while developing models and regimes that are scalable to the whole country. This project is aimed to be turned into the seed that grows into a full model of care change in Ukraine. For doing so, a Biosafety level 3 (BSL3) laboratory is in process of being finalized by MSF for providing accurate diagnosis for the patients.

Main objectives Carrying out assessments and ensuring the implementation, maintenance and monitoring of the Biomed activities including repairs, maintenance of equipment and planning of biomed orders according to MSF protocols and standards in order to ensure the correct use and efficient functioning of the Biomed equipment of the mission
